Costumes

We understand that making costumes are expensive and time consuming. Costumes are therefore selected to provide minimal inconvenience to parents and are issued on a hire basis.

The hire fee is \$30 per outfit, including headgear. Whilst you have paid a hire fee, additional trims and/or minor alterations may be required to improve the costume (please **do not cut** costumes to shorten or if taking in – discuss alterations with reception).

Please note that gluing sequins on costumes is not allowed.

Costumes will be distributed in Term 3. Costumes should be hung-up and stored in a safe place. As costumes are fragile please take special care with them and resist your child's urge to play with them.

As costumes are hired they must be returned on the night of the concert (with exception of some hip hops). Failure to return a costume on the night and in good condition will incur a further fee.

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Concert

Dance Power's end of year performance will once again be held at Plenty Ranges Arts & Convention Centre, South Morang. The theatre offers state of the art facilities and hosts major shows and productions including the Australian Ballet School. Students will perform on stage in full theatrical costumes and make-up. We have been fortunate enough to secure 4 dates - one for our rehearsal and three for our performances.

Merchandise Shoes & Tights

Dance Attire and Shoes

It is important that students wear appropriate clothing and dance shoes in class so teachers can correct dance technique and posture. Leotards, leggings, singlets, dance pants, shorts are appropriate. No denim. Students require the following dance shoes for class and concerts:

Tinys:	Pink ballet shoes (elastic)	
Sub-Jnr:	Pink ballet shoes (elastic) and tan tap shoes	
Jnr:	Pink ballet shoes (elastic), tan taps, black jazz shoes	
Inters/Young Snr:	Black jazz shoes, tan tap shoes, pink ballet shoes (with ribbons for the photos/rehearsal and concerts)	
Нір Нор:	Black jazz shoes	
YngAdv/Snrs/Adv:	Tan tap shoes, ballet or pointe shoes (ribbons), black jazz	
Jnr Cheerleading:	Black jazz shoes	
Inter/Snr Cheer:	Black sand shoes (no split soles) or black jazz	

Ballet ties must be tucked into ballet shoes & ribbons must be sewn on sides and securely tied up, fastened with invisible tape around the ankle.

Tights

Pink ballet tights are required for ballet dances and tan tights for all other styles when performing on stage. For your convenience we have sourced affordable dance tights which can be purchased during classes at Reception (\$12).

Volunteers for End of Year Performance and Theatre Etiquette

Volunteers: Backstage dressers, runners, and helpers are required for each performance.

Please leave your name with reception if you are able to assist. Working With Children needed

Dressing: Due to the limited space available backstage only 3 dressers per group (plus 1 class leader) will be available backstage (except Tinys, Sub-Juniors, Juniors and Boys however we do ask that numbers be limited).

Backstage passes will be distributed later in the year.

Class Leader: One parent is required from each class for each performance night to escort their child's group to side stage when called.

If you are interested please contact reception.

- **Backstage:** Only the 3 dressers and class leaders will be permitted backstage during the rehearsal and concert nights.
- **Theatre:** As requested by Theatre Management, the Theatre will be closed during the Dress Rehearsal. Note also that during each Performance members of the audience will be unable to enter/exit the Theatre except at interval.

Child Safety Backstage - Working With Children

All backstage volunteers must have a current Working With Children Check (WWC). WWC are free and can be obtained online. Please ensure you complete your application now so it arrives before rehearsal. Further all male family members will need to remain in the foyer or boys dressing room only. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding to ensure a safe environment for all students.

Practising your technique, skills and routines is a good way to stretch and stay warm during the winter holidays. Hope you all rest, recharge and have great mid-year break.
